- December 10, 2021: Superintendent's Memo #321-21
 - 2022 monitoring will occur in two rounds winter/spring and summer
 - All monitoring will be conducted virtually
- January 12, 2022: Webinar for first round of school divisions (winter/spring 2022)
- January 21, 2022: Email completed Point of Contact form to vdoefederalrelief@doe.virginia.gov
- March 10, 2022: Email completed monitoring form and evidence to assigned VDOE reviewer
- March April, 2022: VDOE reviewers will conduct follow-up calls
- May 2022: Once the final review is completed, a summary of the monitoring results will be sent to the division superintendent and point of contact
